Mark 5:25-34

- And a woman was there who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years. ²⁶ She had suffered a great deal under the care of many doctors and had spent all she had, yet instead of getting better she grew worse. ²⁷ When she heard about Jesus, she came up behind him in the crowd and touched his cloak, ²⁸ because she thought, “If I just touch his clothes, I will be healed.”

- ²⁹ Immediately her bleeding stopped and she felt in her body that she was freed from her suffering. ³⁰ At once Jesus realized that power had gone out from him. He turned around in the crowd and asked, “Who touched my clothes?” ³¹ “You see the people crowding against you,” his disciples answered, “and yet you can ask, ‘Who touched me?’ ”

- ³² But Jesus kept looking around to see who had done it. ³³ Then the woman, knowing what had happened to her, came and fell at his feet and, trembling with fear, told him the whole truth. ³⁴ He said to her, “Daughter, your faith has healed you. Go in peace and be freed from your suffering.”

1. She Suffers for twelve years.

- Mark 5:25-26, And a woman was there who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years. ²⁶ She had suffered a great deal under the care of many doctors and had spent all she had, yet instead of getting better she grew worse.
- John 16:33, “I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.”


2. She heard about JESUS.

- Mark 5:27-28, **When she heard about Jesus**, she came up behind him in the crowd and touched his cloak, ²⁸ because she thought, “If I just touch his clothes, I will be healed.”
- Acts 1:8, But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

- Romans 10:17, Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word about Christ.

3. She believed in her heart.

- Mark 5: ²⁸, because **she thought**, “If I just touch his clothes, I will be healed.”
- Matthew 21:22, If you **believe**, you will receive whatever you ask for in prayer.
- Mark 5:36, Overhearing what they said, Jesus told him, “Don’t be afraid; just **believe**.”

- Hebrews 11:6, And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him **must believe** that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.

4. She touched Jesus' cloak.

- Mark 5:27, When she heard about Jesus, she came up behind him in the crowd and **touched his cloak**.
- Mark 6:56, And wherever he went—into villages, towns or countryside—they placed the sick in the marketplaces. They begged him to let them touch even the edge of his cloak, and *all who touched it were healed*.

5. She's healed immediately!

- Mark 5:29-30, Immediately her bleeding stopped and she felt in her body that she was freed from her suffering. ³⁰ At once Jesus realized that power had gone out from him.
- Mark 5:34 He said to her, “Daughter, your faith has healed you. Go in peace and be freed from your suffering.”
