Similar Expressions

- **Pity (chânan)** “Have pity upon me, have pity upon me, O ye my friends; for the hand of God hath touched me.” Job 19:21
- **Mercy (cheçed)** “O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good; for his mercy endureth for ever.” 1 Chronicles 16:34
- **Compassion (splanchnízomai)** “But when **he** saw the multitudes, **he** was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd” Matthew 9:36
